THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between El Paso County (hereinafter "COUNTY") on behalf of the El Paso County Juvenile Probation Department (hereinafter "JPD") and the Bexar County Juvenile Board (hereinafter "SUB-RECIPIENT") under the authority and in accordance with the Interlocal Cooperation Act, as set out in Chapter 791, Texas Government Code.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division has made available funding to the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission under a grant maintained under TJPC Strategy Number 3, Probation Assistance (hereinafter referred to as "GRANT") to facilitate statewide training initiatives through the installation of video conferencing equipment for various juvenile probation departments throughout the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY received a one-time distribution of the funds derived from the GRANT for \$145,333.00, to facilitate the procurement of technology infrastructure and equipment for juvenile probation departments throughout the State of Texas to implement video conferencing technology from Data Projections (hereinafter "Vendor") (See Attachment A); and

WHEREAS, the SUB-RECIPIENT agrees to receive and accept the equipment to implement video conferencing technology procured from the COUNTY under the GRANT; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY, on behalf of the JPD, and the SUB-RECIPIENT are each local governments as defined in Texas Government Code, Section 791.003 and have the authority to enter into this Agreement, and have each entered into this Agreement by the action of its governing body in the appropriate manner prescribed by law; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY, on behalf of the JPD and the SUB-RECIPIENT recognize that a coordinated and consolidated effort in fiscal allocation to facilitate statewide training initiatives through the installation of video conferencing equipment to meet the needs of juvenile justice programs and initiatives will result in a cost savings and is in the best interest of the citizens of the COUNTY and the SUB-RECIPIENT; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY on behalf of the JPD specify that each party paying for the performance of said functions of government shall make those payments from current revenues available to the paying party; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions herein which fairly compensate the performing party, it is mutually agreed as follows:

A. PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

The purpose of this Agreement is to establish the terms and conditions whereby the COUNTY on behalf of the JPD shall serve as the fiscal agent to facilitate the purchase and distribution of video conferencing equipment to promote statewide juvenile probation department training initiatives to designated counties throughout the State of Texas, to include the Bexar County Juvenile Probation Department under the GRANT.

B. DUTIES OF THE COUNTY ON BEHALF OF THE JPD

- 1. The JPD shall process invoices submitted by the SUB-RECIPIENT to confirm receipt of equipment directly from VENDOR and process payments made under the GRANT.
- 2. The JPD shall utilize GRANT funds to purchase the items listed in the attached purchase order from VENDOR for the SUB-RECIPIENT (See Attachment B).

C. DUTIES OF SUB-RECIPIENT

- 1. SUB-RECIPIENT shall submit invoices and receiving copy of purchase orders for the video conferencing equipment received from the VENDOR. Invoices and receiving copies of the purchase order must be signed by an authorized representative of the SUB-RECIPIENT and submitted to the JPD within five (5) working days of delivery and installation of equipment, but no later than August 31, 2011, whichever date is sooner; in order for the JPD to process payment to the VENDOR.
- 2. SUB-RECIPIENT will contact the VENDOR directly for any questions or service issues regarding the video conferencing equipment. SUB-RECIPIENT acknowledges that the COUNTY, the El Paso County Juvenile Board, and the JPD are not responsible for the delivery, installation, maintenance and services of VENDOR's video conferencing equipment and related technology. SUB-RECIPIENT acknowledges that my signing invoice and receiving copy of the purchase order that video conferencing equipment is the property of SUB-RECIPIENT.
- 3. SUB-RECPIENT shall utilize video conferencing equipment only for the purposes as outlined by the GRANT.

D. TERM AND TERMINATION; NOTICE.

1. This Agreement shall be effective upon its execution by all parties and shall terminate when all video conferencing equipment awarded under the GRANT has been delivered and installed and SUB-RECIPIENT complies with the requirements under subsection C. 1. of this Agreement.

The parties further recognize that each is engaged exclusively in the provision of governmental services in each party's participation in this Agreement.
- 3. <u>Legal Relationship; Liability.</u> Nothing contained herein shall be construed as creating the relationship of employer and employee, or principal or agent, among the Parties. Each Party to this Agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this Agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other Party or Parties.
- 4. Release of Liability. The COUNTY, El Paso County Juvenile Board, and the JPD are not responsible or liable for the delivery, installation, maintenance, warranties and services of VENDOR's video conferencing equipment and related technology. SUB-RECIPIENT acknowledges that all delivery,

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN EL PASO COUNTY ON BEHALF OF

THE EL PASO COUNTY JUVENILE PROBATION DEPARTMENT

AND

THE MCLENNAN COUNTY JUVENILE PROBATION BOARD TO PROVIDE VIDEO CONFERENCING EQUIPMENT

UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION GRANT UNDER TJPC STRATEGY NUMBER 3, PROBATION ASSISTANCE

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between El Paso County (hereinafter "COUNTY") on behalf of the El Paso County Juvenile Probation Department (hereinafter "JPD") and the McLennan County Juvenile Board (hereinafter "SUB-RECIPIENT") under the authority and in accordance with the Interlocal Cooperation Act, as set out in Chapter 791, Texas Government Code.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division has made available funding to the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission under a grant maintained under TJPC Strategy Number 3, Probation Assistance (hereinafter referred to as "GRANT") to facilitate statewide training initiatives through the installation of video conferencing equipment for various juvenile probation departments throughout the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY received a one-time distribution of the funds derived from the GRANT for \$145,333.00, to facilitate the procurement of technology infrastructure and equipment for juvenile probation departments throughout the State of Texas to implement video conferencing technology from Data Projections (hereinafter "Vendor") (See Attachment A); and

WHEREAS, the SUB-RECIPIENT agrees to receive and accept the equipment to implement video conferencing technology procured from the COUNTY under the GRANT; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY, on behalf of the JPD, and the SUB-RECIPIENT are each local governments as defined in Texas Government Code, Section 791.003 and have the authority to enter into this Agreement, and have each entered into this Agreement by the action of its governing body in the appropriate manner prescribed by law; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY, on behalf of the JPD and the SUB-RECIPIENT recognize that a coordinated and consolidated effort in fiscal allocation to facilitate statewide training initiatives through the installation of video conferencing equipment to meet the needs of juvenile justice programs and initiatives will result in a cost savings and is in the best interest of the citizens of the COUNTY and the SUB-RECIPIENT; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY on behalf of the JPD specify that each party paying for the performance of said functions of government shall make those payments from current revenues available to the paying party; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions herein which fairly compensate the performing party, it is mutually agreed as follows:

A. PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

The purpose of this Agreement is to establish the terms and conditions whereby the COUNTY on behalf of the JPD shall serve as the fiscal agent to facilitate the purchase and distribution of video conferencing equipment to promote statewide juvenile probation department training initiatives to designated counties throughout the State of Texas, to include the McLennan County Juvenile Probation Department under the GRANT.

B. DUTIES OF THE COUNTY ON BEHALF OF THE JPD

- 1. The JPD shall process invoices submitted by the SUB-RECIPIENT to confirm receipt of equipment directly from VENDOR and process payments made under the GRANT.
- 2. The JPD shall utilize GRANT funds to purchase the items listed in the attached purchase order from VENDOR for the SUB-RECIPIENT (See Attachment B).

C. <u>DUTIES OF SUB-RECIPIENT</u>

- 1. SUB-RECIPIENT shall submit invoices and receiving copy of purchase orders for the video conferencing equipment received from the VENDOR. Invoices and receiving copies of the purchase order must be signed by an authorized representative of the SUB-RECIPIENT and submitted to the JPD within five (5) working days of delivery and installation of equipment, but no later than August 31, 2011, whichever date is sooner; in order for the JPD to process payment to the VENDOR.
- 2. SUB-RECIPIENT will contact the VENDOR directly for any questions or service issues regarding the video conferencing equipment. SUB-RECIPIENT acknowledges that the COUNTY, the El Paso County Juvenile Board, and the JPD are not responsible for the delivery, installation, maintenance and services of VENDOR's video conferencing equipment and related technology. SUB-RECIPIENT acknowledges that my signing invoice and receiving copy of the purchase order that video conferencing equipment is the property of SUB-RECIPIENT.
- 3. SUB-RECPIENT shall utilize video conferencing equipment only for the purposes as outlined by the GRANT.

D. TERM AND TERMINATION; NOTICE.

1. This Agreement shall be effective upon its execution by all parties and shall terminate when all video conferencing equipment awarded under the GRANT has

been delivered and installed and SUB-RECIPIENT complies with the requirements under subsection C. 1. of this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions herein which fairly compensate the performing party, it is mutually agreed as follows:

A. PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

The purpose of this Agreement is to establish the terms and conditions whereby the COUNTY on behalf of the JPD shall serve as the fiscal agent to facilitate the purchase and distribution of video conferencing equipment to promote statewide juvenile probation department training initiatives to designated counties throughout the State of Texas, to include the Tarrant County Juvenile Probation Department under the GRANT.

B. DUTIES OF THE COUNTY ON BEHALF OF THE JPD

- 1. The JPD shall process invoices submitted by the SUB-RECIPIENT to confirm receipt of equipment directly from VENDOR and process payments made under the GRANT.
- 2. The JPD shall utilize GRANT funds to purchase the items listed in the attached purchase order from VENDOR for the SUB-RECIPIENT (See Attachment B).

C. DUTIES OF SUB-RECIPIENT

- 1. SUB-RECIPIENT shall submit invoices and the receiving copy of purchase orders for the video conferencing equipment received from the VENDOR. Invoices and the receiving copies of the purchase order must be signed by an authorized representative of the SUB-RECIPIENT and submitted to the JPD within five (5) working days of delivery and installation of equipment, but no later than August 31, 2011, whichever date is sooner; in order for the JPD to process payment to the VENDOR.
- 2. SUB-RECIPIENT will contact the VENDOR directly for any questions or service issues regarding the video conferencing equipment. SUB-RECIPIENT acknowledges that the COUNTY, the El Paso County Juvenile Board, and the JPD are not responsible for the delivery, installation, maintenance and services of VENDOR's video conferencing equipment and related technology. SUB-RECIPIENT acknowledges that by signing the invoice and the receiving copy of the purchase order that video conferencing equipment is the property of SUB-RECIPIENT.
- 3. SUB-RECPIENT shall utilize video conferencing equipment only for the purposes as outlined by the GRANT.

D. TERM AND TERMINATION; NOTICE.

- 1. This Agreement shall be effective upon its execution by all parties and shall terminate when all video conferencing equipment awarded under the GRANT has been delivered and installed and SUB-RECIPIENT complies with the requirements under subsection C. 1. of this Agreement.
- 2. Any party may terminate this Agreement as of any date, by giving written notice, via certified return receipt requested, of such intent to the other party at least ten (10) days in advance, to the other Parties address as follows:

F. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Unless modified by law, the COUNTY and the SUB-RECPIENT shall comply with all laws, regulations, government policies, in expending funds under this Agreement or the GRANT.
- 2. <u>No Waiver of Immunity.</u> Each Party reserves, and does not waive, its respective rights of immunity and similar rights and does not waive its rights under the applicable statutes. The parties to this Agreement, as governmental entities under the law of the State of Texas, retain their full sovereign and governmental immunity in executing this Agreement and performing any services hereunder. Nothing in this Agreement shall waive, limit or restrict either party's sovereign or governmental immunity to suit or damages. The parties further recognize that each is engaged exclusively in the provision of governmental services in each party's participation in this Agreement.
- 3. <u>Legal Relationship; Liability.</u> Nothing contained herein shall be construed as creating the relationship of employer and employee, or principal or agent, among the Parties. Each Party to this Agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this Agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other Party or Parties.

- 4. Release of Liability. The COUNTY, El Paso County Juvenile Board, and the JPD are not responsible or liable for the delivery, installation, maintenance, warranties and services of VENDOR's video conferencing equipment and related technology. SUB-RECIPIENT acknowledges that all delivery, installation, maintenance, services and warranties are the responsibility of the VENDOR and shall direct all inquiries to the VENDOR.
- 5. <u>Amendments.</u> This Agreement may be amended by mutual agreement of all Parties hereto in writing to be attached to and incorporated into this Agreement.
- 6. <u>Legal Construction; Severability</u>. In case anyone or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect such invalidity, illegality, or un-enforceability shall not affect any other provision thereof and this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.
- 7. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. This Agreement supersedes any and all other agreements, either oral or in writing, between the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof, and no other agreement, statement, or promise relating to the subject matter of this Agreement which is not contained herein shall be valid or binding.

Amendment Number Twelve

Applicable to EL PASO County

This is Amendment Number Twelve to the State Financial Assistance Contract for the 2010 - 2011 Biennium between the State of Texas, represented by and through the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission, hereinafter called "the Commission", and the juvenile board of EL PASO County hereinafter called the "Grantee". In consideration of the mutual agreements contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Commission and the Grantee, for the consideration hereinafter detailed, make the following amendment.

Article I. PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF AMENDMENT

The purpose of Amendment Number Twelve is to delineate the duties of the Commission and the Grantee regarding the distribution, receipt and expenditure of grant funding to assist the EL PASO County Juvenile Board to facilitate statewide training initiatives through the installation of video conferencing equipment at the headquarters of the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission and at strategic locations across the state. All provisions in the 2010 - 2011 Biennium State Financial Assistance Contract and any fully executed amendments thereto that do not conflict with the provisions of Amendment Number Twelve remain in full force and effect.

Article II. Amendments to Article II INCORPORATED DOCUMENTS AND DOCUMENT INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE

Article II, Section 2.1, Subsection 2.1.1 is amended by adding Paragraph 2.1.1.13 to read as follows:

2.1.1.13 Exhibit M. Video Conferencing (Amendment Twelve).

Article III. Amendments to Article II DOCUMENTS INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE

Article II, paragraph 2.2 Subsection 2.2.1 regarding the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission Compliance Resource Manual, is amended in the State Aid (Grant A) as follows:

Article VIII, Section A is amended by adding under Subsection 6 - Allowable Expenditures to read as follows:

6. The Grantee may use funds distributed under this grant to procure technology infrastructure and equipment to implement video conferencing in EL PASO County and other designated counties. Upon request or audit by the Commission, the Grantee shall submit all receipts, purchase orders or other documentation of authorized expenditures no later than April 29, 2011. The Grantee shall meet the following system compatibility requirements for the equipment procured under this grant. Video conference equipment and/or hardware shall be compatible with the following: HDX7000, HDX6000 and E-3 VBP. The Grantee shall coordinate with the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission on the details of the purchase and equipment distribution.

Article IV.

Amendments to Article IV to the State Financial Assistance Contract OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COMMISSION VIDEO CONFERENCING

Article IV, Section 4.1 is amended by adding Subsections 4.1.15 to read as follows:

4.1.15 Video Conferencing. To the extent funds are available, the Commission shall allocate a one-time distribution of the funds derived from the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division grant maintained under TJPC Strategy Number 3, Probation Assistance in an amount not to exceed \$145,333.00 to be expended no later than April 29, 2011. These funds shall be expended to procure technology infrastructure and equipment to implement video conferencing at the headquarters of the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission and at strategic locations across the state.

For the faithful performance of the terms of this Contract, the parties hereto in their capacities as stated, execute this Contract, affix their signatures and bind themselves.
