How to Register a Septic Tank


Requirements:

1. The Septic System must have been constructed before 8/24/1988; Septic tanks must be made of concrete, fiberglass, or reinforced plastic polyethylene (No cinder block is allowed), and proof in the form of one of the following:

- A letter from The Electric Company (543-5970) stating that service has existed on property prior to 8/24/1988 or
- An aerial map of your property showing a dwelling prior to 8/24/1988. Aerials can be obtained by calling the Engineering Dept. at City Hall (4th floor) at 541-4429.

2. The Septic System must be water tight without any cracks or perforations.

If you meet the requirements:

1. Complete a registration application. Applications can be obtained from <http://www.epcounty.com/rb/> or at El Paso County on-Site Department located at 14612 Greg, "C".
 2. Pay the registration fee at any of the following County Clerk's office locations:
 - Ysleta Annex Office, 9521 Socorro Rd., Suite A1
 - Northeast Annex Office, 4641 Cohen, Suite B
 - County Courthouse, 500 E. San Antonio, Suite 105
- DO NOT PAY IF SYSTEM DOES NOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS.
FEE IS NOT REFUNDABLE**
3. Prepare for an inspection to verify that the septic system meets the requirements to be registered by:
 - Exposing the inlet and outlet lines
 - Expose about 6 inches around the tank
 - Expose a portion of the drain field
