El Paso County Seeks Chairperson for Bond Advisory Committee

EL PASO, TX— In its ongoing commitment to transparent governance, fiscal responsibility, and community development, El Paso County announces the formation of the County Bond Advisory Committee (BoAC). The committee, which will play a vital role in guiding the issuance and utilization of bonds within the county, is currently seeking a dedicated Chairperson.

The BoAC has been established to be a pivotal force in shaping the responsible issuance and utilization of bonds by El Paso County. The Chairperson will be essential in ensuring that bond initiatives are in line with the best interests of the community.

Duties will include presiding over meetings, leading committee meetings, ensuring productive and inclusive discussions. The Chairperson will also be responsible for representing the committee as a spokesperson with the County Commissioners Court and the public. This role will also provide strategic leadership in directing and collaborating with committee members. Lastly, they will uphold transparency by ensuring accountability in the County's bond-related processes.

The County is seeking candidates with a deep understanding of bond issuance and fiscal management, prior leadership experience, and a commitment to responsible governance and community engagement. The Chairperson will serve a single term, attending a total of six meetings during their tenure.
